

Special Considerations

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. If using the snowmobile trails to haul while they are open enough snow must remain on the trail to keep them useable.
3. Biomass Harvesting is not allowed.
4. All obvious cavity trees leave standing. All hollow or cavity log ends leave in the woods. All standing dead trees leave uncut.
5. All slash along County Hwy. J will be pulled back 20 feet from the tree line.
6. Any skid trails along Hwy. J will be parallel to the road and located no closer than 20 feet from the tree line.
7. No cutting and/or skidding will be allowed from April 15 To July 15 due to Oak wilt restrictions.

-  Marked Hardwood Area (45 acres): Cut all ironwood and trees marked with orange paint. Canopy gaps are marked with purple painted trees. All purple marked trees and all stems interior of the gap, including all 1 to 5 inch trees, are to be cut.
-  Oak Area (27 acres): Cut all merchantable maple, ironwood, balsam fir and trees marked with orange paint.
-  Oak/Pine Release Area (20 acres): Cut same as above, but take extra care to not damage the 1 to 5 inch residual trees.
