


Northern Highland American Legion State Forest

The objectives for this part of the Forest are to increase the presence and age of red pine and white pine in all timber types. Additionally, the aspen component is to be maintained as a dominant community on the landscape.

The pine areas are composed of both plantation and older natural stands. The year of origin for the plantation areas is 1974. The year of origin for the natural stands is 1900. Within these red pine types roughly one-third of the trees will be harvested. This technique will maintain the growth and vigor of the remaining trees and meet the objectives for the area.

No seasonal restrictions will be imposed and biomass harvesting will not be allowed due to nutrient poor soils.
