

Objectives for Management Area 4 are increase the presence and age of red pine and white pine, maintain sites with early-successional forest types, and maintain aspen as a dominant community. Objectives for Management Area 12 are to enhance the development of a mixed forest dominated by old trees, large amounts of coarse woody debris, numerous standing dead snags, and an age diversity of trees. Objectives for Management Area 20 are to increase the red and white pine and red oak dominance across most of the mixed forest as opportunities arise.

Stand 2 is a 105 year old, 20 acre, large-saw red oak stand with a heavy aspen component. This stand will see the aspen harvested to promote oak.

Stand 12 is a 108 year old, 14 acre, large-saw white pine and red pine stand that will be thinned.

Stand 15 is a 61 year old, 20 acre, oak, red maple, and aspen stand. Part of this stand is at the corner of Hwy M and Hwy N and the bike trail. Thinning in this stand will promote oak.

Stand 17 is a 33 acre scenic lake zone. This stand will be managed for longer lived species such as oak and white pine.

Stand 18 is a 58 year old, 17 acre, red maple stand with oak and a mix of other species. Coppice with standards harvest.

Large trees to be retained and slash treated to reduce visual impacts by Hwy N and Little John Jr. Lake.

Biomass harvest is not approved due to dry, nutrient poor soils.

Access is off Hwy M and Hwy N to a network of snowmobile trails and woods roads.
