



The objectives for this part of the Forest are to increase the presence and age of red pine and white pine in all timber types. Additionally, the aspen component is to be maintained as a dominant community on the landscape.

The RED PINE MIX areas are composed primarily of variable stocked natural red pine with associated species present to some degree. There is a significant understory of red maple throughout portions of this stand. Within these red pine types roughly one-third of the trees will be harvested. The majority of short-lived species will be harvested. This technique will maintain the growth and vigor of the remaining trees and meet the objectives for the area. Year of origin for the pine type is 1923.

No seasonal restrictions will be imposed and biomass harvesting will not be allowed due to nutrient poor soils.
