



One main objective for this part of the Forest is to enhance the development of a mixed forest dominated by old trees. Additional objectives are to maintain mid-tolerant tree species and increase the overall age of the forest.

The OAK areas will undergo an intermediate thin removing roughly one-third of the trees. A significant portion of the short-lived species and maple will be harvested along with lesser amounts of oak. Plans are to manage on an ecological rotation for oak. Year of origin for the oak stand is 1907.

In the NORTHERN HARDWOOD areas an all-aged management scenario will be implemented relying on canopy gaps to incorporate some diversity into the stand and move the type more to an all-aged regime. Overall, roughly one-third of the trees will be harvested here as well but with a more variable density.

Seasonal restrictions will be imposed related to oak wilt threats and biomass harvesting will not be allowed due to Native Community designation.
