No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 422 acres.

The contract period is 3½ years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4” top diameter will be cut and utilized.

¹Approximately 70% White Pine, 25% Red Pine and 5% Balsam Fir. Included within this volume are 300 MBF of White Pine and 100 MBF of Red Pine. Weight conversion 2.14 tons/cord.

²Approximately 25 MBF of Basswood logs included within estimate.

³Approximately 45% White Birch, 35% Soft Maple, 15% Hard Maple, and 5% Red Oak. Included within this volume is 3 MBF of Soft Maple, 2 MBF of Hard Maple, and 1 MBF of Red Oak. Weight conversion 2.40 tons/cord.

Total sale volume equates to 35 tons/acre.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. No wheeled or tracked equipment will be allowed within 15’ of the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM) for Trilby Lake or the unnamed lake to the north. In addition, equipment use within 50’ of the OHWM of the lakes will be limited to when the soil is frozen or dry enough to prevent rutting.
3. Leave standing, when possible, all dead trees and all trees with obvious cavities.
4. No cutting or skidding will be allowed from April 15 to July 15 in the 9-acre OAK AREA. Frozen winter access will be required for both HARDWOOD AREAS.
5. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract “pull-off” inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the “pull-off” inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.



- Aspen Area (76 Acres):
Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple,
white birch, ironwood and trees
marked with orange paint.
- Oak Area (9 Acres):
Cut all maple and trees
marked with orange paint.
- Pine Area (259 Acres):
Cut all merchantable maple, balsam fir and aspen. Cut all trees
marked with orange paint.



- Lake Zone South (28 Acres): Cut all aspen and white birch NOT marked with green paint. Cut all orange marked trees.
- Hardwood Area (44 Acres): Cut all aspen and trees marked with orange paint. Frozen ground access only.
- Lake Zone West (6 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees.
