No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 75 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Whole Tree harvest is not allowed.

1 White Pine is approximately 42% white pine, 38% red pine, and 20% jack pine. Included is a potential for 19 MBF red pine logs and 26 MBF white pine logs. (wt. conv. 2.162 tons/cord)

2 Red Oak contains an estimated 18 MBF of sawlogs.


3 Mixed Hardwood is approximately 74% red maple, 25% white birch, and 1% hard maple. (wt. conv 2.310 tons/cord)

Note: Total sale volume equates to 44 tons/acre or 19 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
2. No equipment use allowed in ephemeral ponds or wetlands. Do not deposit slash in wetlands.
3. Slash within aesthetic zones must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
4. Do not operate forestry equipment on paved bike trail.
5. No harvesting or skidding in the Mixed Forest Stands or Scenic Lake Zone from April 15th to July 15th due to the risk of oak wilt.
6. No log landings or road building allowed in the Scenic Lake Zone.
7. No nighttime operations allowed around Little John Jr Lake during the camping season.
8. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.
9. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

- Mixed Forest (37 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, white birch, maple, and orange marked trees.
- Scenic Lake Zone (25 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple, white birch, jack pine, and orange marked trees.
- Pine (13 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, white birch, maple, and orange marked trees.

No Harvesting or Skidding in Mixed Forest or Scenic Lake Zone from April 15th to July 15th due to the risk of oak wilt.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint. Do not operate equipment within 20 ft of paved trail.
