LUMP SUM SALE – 50% of the bid value must be paid before harvesting begins.

No bid bond required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 43 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4” top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.

¹Approximately 95% Red Pine, 5% Jack Pine, and less than 1% of Balsam Fir and White Pine. Approximately 5% of the Red Pine volume is sawlog sized material. Weight Conversion: 2.24 tons/cord.


²Approximately 98% Aspen, 1% Red Maple, and 1% White Birch. Weight Conversion: 2.25 tons/cord.

Total Sale Volume equates to 31.40 tons/acre or 13.95 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. LUMP SUM SALE: 50% of the total lump sum bid value must be paid prior to cutting. The remaining 50% will be due when the administering forester determines 50% of the area has been harvested. All unmarked or undesignated operational trees require prior approval before cutting. All operational trees or damaged trees will be decked for scaling and will be billed in addition to the original sale amount at the stumpage rate which was bid. Any trees cut without prior approval will subject the contractor to penalties and fines.
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
4. Slash within fifty-feet of Oxbow Road must be lopped to within two-feet of the ground and all tops and slash must be pulled back into the tree line concurrently with cutting. No slash allowed within the graded portion of the road or within the ditch line.
