

WILLOW FLOWAGE TRACT NO. 015-16

Upper Willow Dam Road

No bid bond required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for the performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 132 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.

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
<sup>1</sup> Red Pine volume includes approximately 68% red pine and 32% white pine. Volume also includes approximately 58 MBF red pine logs and 8 MBF white pine logs.

<sup>2</sup> Mixed hardwood volume includes approximately 86% red maple and 14% white birch.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. All landings require prior approval.
3. All trails and roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition.
4. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees, including understory pine regeneration, must be avoided.
5. No harvest activity is allowed in the Scenic Resources Area from May 20<sup>th</sup> to September 18<sup>th</sup>.
6. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed adjacent to the Tomahawk River and wetlands and kegs throughout the sale area.
  - A. No wheeled or tracked vehicles permitted to operate in the wetland.
  - B. Trees may not be felled into wetland areas.
  - C. No slash shall be deposited into wetland areas.
  - D. No equipment will be allowed within 15' of the river's edge.
7. All roads must be returned to their original condition.
8. Biomass harvesting is not approved on this sale.

Aspen Regeneration/ Pine Thinning Area (108 Acres): Harvest all aspen, birch, maple, balsam, jack pine (including 1-5" trees) and trees marked with orange paint.

Scenic Resources Area (24 Acres): Cut all balsam fir (including 1-5" trees) and trees marked with orange paint.

***There is no harvesting allowed between May 15th and September 15***

***Note: Do not cut trees marked with green paint.***
