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NHAL Timber Sale Bid Mailing List:

Enclosed please find a Northern Highlands American Legion State Forest prospectus sheet and timber sale management maps for the upcoming bid opening. **Minimum total bid prices are listed for each sale. Advertised per unit prices do not need to be met. An acceptable bid must be equal to the total minimum bid price or higher. All species and products must be bid on or bids will be rejected.**

NEW TO THIS BID OPENING, ALL PULPWOOD WILL BE SOLD AS TONS.

Included in this prospectus are descriptions of the individual timber sales, volumes and minimum total bid prices. Please note that there are **BIOMASS HARVESTING GUIDELINES**.

Biomass harvest is the removal of fine woody debris (fuel rods/tops of trees) and non-merchantable standing trees designated for cutting on harvest sites for fuel. It also prohibits harvest of down coarse woody debris already present on the ground. Whole tree harvest for paper chips does not qualify for the fuelwood price. If a sale is bid whole tree chip volume, then the 4" top of the tree and smaller will be charged at the pulpwood price. The fuelwood price is \$2.00/ton. The volume is approximately equal to the difference between 4" top cordage and whole tree volume. Fuelwood will be added to a contract if utilized. A sale will be noted on the prospectus if Biomass Harvest is approved for that sale. Otherwise, no biomass can be removed.

Successful purchasers of Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest stumpage will need to ensure that the actual logging contractor complies with the Wisconsin Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) Training Standard as adopted by the Wisconsin SFI Implementation Committee (SIC). To qualify for state sales all loggers must meet certain criteria to be considered a "Qualified Logging or Resource Professional.

We also want to repeat our policy of required **pre-sale meetings** with the forester in charge of administration for each sale. The Forestry Headquarters needs to hear from you prior (a week is best) to moving onto sales for harvest and prior to site harvest set up of landings and wood roads.
