

Parkway Pine Timber Sale (TRACT 3810-2-14) – Scale Sale

Property: Peshtigo River State Forest

Location: Town of Stephenson (Sections 3 & 4, T33N, R18E), Marinette County

- ✓ 77 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
 - 430 cords red pine
 - 180 cords aspen
 - 40 cords jack pine
 - 30 cords scrub oak
- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2016
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between July 15 and April 15. Portions of roads and/or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ During the open snowmobile season, trails may only be used for trucking, NOT forwarding or decking and must be kept free of brush and debris.
- ✓ Annosum treatment is required on conifer stumps
- ✓ Harvest restrictions are as follows:
 - Red Pine Plantations: Harvesting can only occur between July 15th and April 15th, except areas of pine plantation which contain little oak may be harvested any time of year.
 - Frozen ground conditions may be required for operation in red pine plantations within 200 feet of water (no soil disturbance).
 - Clearcut Areas: Harvesting can only occur between July 15th and April 15th

Location: Town of Stephenson (Sections 9, 10 & 11, T33N, R18E), Marinette County

- ✓ 140 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
 - 650 cords aspen
 - 50 cords red pine
 - 70 cords jack pine
 - 120 cords oak
 - 500 cords mixed hardwood
 - 70 MBF other oak (approximately 50% scrub oak/ 50% red oak)
 - Oak sawtimber >10" (small end) will be scaled as logs

- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2016
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between July 15 and April 15. Portions of roads and/or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ Annosum treatment is required on conifer stumps
- ✓ Harvest time restrictions are as follows (see sale map for specifics):
 - All cutting units EXCEPT West Block Aspen Clearcut: Harvesting can only occur between July 15th and April 15th.
- ✓ Biomass Suitability: No
- ✓ Hauling from West Block Aspen – special notes:
 - Hauling through Governor Thompson State Park may only occur under frozen ground conditions.
 - Hauling through private property to the east is negotiable at the contractor’s discretion and expense.

Location: Town of Stephenson (Section 1, T32N, R18E; Section 7, T32N R19E; Section 31, T33N, R19E), Marinette County

- ✓ 59 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
 - 420 cords aspen
 - 460 cords scrub oak
 - 120 cords mixed Hardwood
- ✓ The contract period will be until July 1, 2016
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between October 15th and April 1st. Portions of roads and/ or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ During the open snowmobile season, trails may only be used for trucking, NOT forwarding or decking and must be kept free of brush and debris.
- ✓ Harvest time restrictions are as follows (see sale map for specifics):
 - North Clearcut Areas: Harvesting can only occur between October 15th and April 1st.
 - South Clearcut Areas: Harvesting can only occur between July 15th and April 15th.
- ✓ Biomass Suitability: No
- ✓ Silt fence and erosion control measures must be installed and maintained by the contractor along unnamed creek to the west of Lands End Lane and south of High Falls Road prior to and during harvesting and trucking operations.
