


Chronic Wasting Disease Prevalence

A preliminary spatial evaluation of the deer removed from the 2002 Disease Eradication Zone (DEZ) and 2002 Intensive Harvest Zone (IHZ) was done to identify areas with different disease prevalence. Three areas with different levels of CWD prevalence were identified: a "high prevalence" zone in the center of the DEZ (7% prevalence, in red), a surrounding "intermediate prevalence" area (2% prevalence, in orange) and a "low prevalence" area (<1% prevalence, in yellow).
