




**WISCONSIN DNR

LAKE OF THE PINES, SAWYER COUNTY, 2013**

The Department of Natural Resources conducted a fisheries assessment of Lake Of The Pines, Sawyer County, from May 09, 2013 to May 12, 2013.


Lake of the Pines is a 273 acre drainage lake with a maximum depth of 39 feet. The fishery includes muskellunge, panfish, largemouth bass and walleye. The population estimate for adult walleye is slightly below average for area lakes with similar characteristics.

Other Species

Other species observed but not included in this report were bluegill, common shiner, golden shiner, largemouth bass, northern pike, pumpkinseed, rock bass, white sucker, and yellow perch.

We are also conducting a creel (angler harvest) survey on Lake Of The Pines this year. Creel clerk Donna Sorensen will count and interview anglers and examine their catch throughout the fishing season.

A brief summary of selected fishing regulations is included below. While the regulatory information provided was current at the time the surveys were conducted, it is not comprehensive and should not be used as a substitute for the current fishing regulation pamphlet. General Fishing Regulations for Lake Of The Pines, Sawyer County, 2013

FISH SPECIES	OPEN SEASON	DAILY LIMIT	MINIMUM LENGTH
Walleye	May 04-March 02	5	15" MINIMUM
Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass	June 15-March 02	5	14" MINIMUM
Muskellunge	May 25-November 30	1	40" MINIMUM
Northern Pike	May 04-March 02	5	NO MINIMUM

This report is interim only; data and findings should not be considered final. Results of creel surveys should be available by June of the year following the survey.
