

# Kohler-Andrae State Park

## A Guide for You and Your Pet

Pets must be on a leash no longer than 8 feet and under your control at all times. Pets are allowed at your campsite, along park roads, the Black River Hiking Trail, the Black River Marsh Boardwalk, Marsh Trail, designated sections of the Kohler Dunes Cordwalk, the Fishing Pond Trail and on the beach area north of the Nature Center only.

Pets are not allowed on the beach area south of the Sanderling Nature Center, picnic areas, playgrounds, buildings or nature trails. If you decide to go exploring, please take your pet with you. Do not leave your pet unattended. This includes in your vehicle, tent or camper.

Barking dogs disturb others. Please leave vocal dogs at home. Pet waste must be removed by the owner. Do not bury it in the sand. Make sure your dog's vaccinations are up to date. It is a state law. Your pet may encounter wildlife not in perfect health.

Pet rule violations are subject to fines and are strictly enforced to provide a safe and clean state park for all our visitors. The citation for unleashed pets or pets in unauthorized areas (NR45.06(1)) is \$175.30 (subject to change).
