## RESOLUTION

**Whereas** Wisconsin snowmobile trails have serious nighttime safety issues and there is an obligation to increase the safety for all trail users.

**Whereas** the State Trails Council suggests that formal speed limits be enacted, and that operating a snowmobile under the influence of intoxicants or drug be tied to the operator's driver license.

**Whereas** it is recommended the leaders in the snowmobile community, DNR and legislators support appropriate changes in laws governing snowmobile operation.

**It is therefore RESOLVED** that the State Trails Council formally support legislation to make snowmobile trails and tourism safer in the state of Wisconsin.
