PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION
SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT No. WI-0065455-01-0

Facility Where Discharge Occurs: Anderson Custom Processing, PO Box 76, 220 Serv-Us St., Belleville, WI 53508

Receiving Water and Location: Sugar River, (Upper Sugar Watershed – SP15 of the Sugar Pecatonica Rivers Basin) in Dane County in the NW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 34, Township 5 North, Range 8 East

Brief Facility Description: Anderson Custom Processing is located in Belleville, Wisconsin (Dane County). This facility provides custom spray drying services for food, beverage, infant formula, pharmaceuticals, as well as hair care, cosmetic and paper products industries. Non-contact cooling water is discharged directly into Sugar Creek. Wastewater containing a mixture of corn starch process water and softer regeneration water is stored on-site in above-ground tanks prior to being land applied under ch. NR 214 Wis. Adm. Code. The average annual wastewater volume is approximately 15,000 gpd. Process wastewaters are, at times, treated for pH adjustment prior to landspreading. The wastewater does not include any sanitary wastewater. The facility previously used an independent contractor to landspread wastewaters and had coverage under WPDES general permit no. WI-0044938-05-0 for noncontact cooling water discharge.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above specified WPDES permit should be issued for this new discharge.

Limitations and conditions which the Department believes adequately protect the receiving water are included in the proposed permit. Land application of waste shall be done in accordance with permit conditions and applicable codes. All land application sites shall be approved prior to their use. To receive a list of approved sites, or to be notified of potential approvals, contact the permit drafter.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Anyone providing comments in response to this public notice will receive a notification of the Department's final decision when the permit is issued. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination. If no comments are received on the proposed permit from anyone, including U.S. EPA, the permit will be issued as proposed.

The Department may schedule a public informational hearing if requested by any person and shall schedule a public informational hearing if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons or if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Stats. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at the hearing.

Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit, fact sheet (if required), and permit application, may be inspected and copied at the permit drafter's or the compliance staff's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter or compliance staff for directions to their office location, if necessary. Information on this permit action may also be obtained by calling the permit drafter at (920) 387-7886 or by writing to the Department. Reasonable costs (usually 20 cents per page) will be charged for copies of information in the file other than the public notice and fact sheet.
