Then, relate what they have learned to the operation of an ATV/Snowmobile.</p> <p><u>E-EDUCATE</u></p> <p>The Law: No person can operate an ATV/snowmobile while under the influence of an intoxicant to a degree, which renders him or her incapable of safe ATV/snowmobile operation.
